Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Hamilton Experience?

Through collaboration with [Broadway Plus](#) two Broadway Artists from Hamilton are coming to Hocking County to share their stories, talents, and expertise in a series of Workshops on music and dances from Hamilton. That evening, the workshop attendees and the artists will hold a concert for the community.

Who are the two Broadway artists?

The two artists coming are [Darilyn Castillo](#) and [Christopher Henry Young](#), both who performed alongside Lin-Manuel Miranda. Darilyn as Peggy Schuyler and Maria Richards; Christopher played Charles Lee, Samuel Seabury, George Eaker, and James Reynolds.

Are there other Workshop Leaders?

Yes, Robyn Lindsey ([RL Dance](#)) and Clarence McCoy ([Director, Lancaster Community Chorus](#)) will also be presenters. Every Workshop participant will have one workshop with each of the four Workshop Presenters.

What is the “class size” of the workshops?

Each workshop is held to 25 participants, so every person attending will be sure to have individualized attention from the four workshop leaders.

What material will participants be learning?

Two of the Workshops will be focused on dance from Hamilton (hip hop and jazz with Christopher Henry Young and Robyn Lindsey) and two of the workshops will be focused on music from Hamilton (“Alexander Hamilton”, “Dear Theodosia”, “Who Lives, Who Dies, Who Tells Your Story”, with Darilyn Castillo and Clarence McCoy).

Who can participate in the Hamilton Experience

50 students (Grades 7 through 12th Grade in the 2025-2026 school year) and 50 adults (high school graduate – senior citizen) may register.

Please note space is limited, and availability varies based on age/grade level.

Where is the Hamilton Experience?

The Hamilton Experience Workshops will be held at the Logan High School.

The concert on Saturday night will be at the Logan High School Theatre.

How much does the Hamilton Experience cost?

The cost for students (Grades 7 – 12) is \$50.00

The cost for adults is \$75.00

The registration fee covers 4 workshops and reserved seating at the evening concert.

How can people get tickets for the Concert?
